Guidelines for the Joyce Bauer National Scholarship

- 1. Must be a current, active member of the Administrative Personnel Association.
- 2. The amount of each scholarship will be \$150 to offset the cost of attending the National Conference.
- 3. The number of scholarships awarded will be determined by the National Conference Scholarship Committee on an annual basis.
- 4. Priority consideration will be given to applicants attending the National Conference for the first time.
- 5. Financial need will be considered when an applicant does not receive or receives limited continuing education funds.
- 6. Ordinarily scholarships will not be awarded to an applicant in consecutive years.
